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## HIC Fees for Industry – Sponsored Research

Wayne State University charges for Human Investigation Committee (HIC) review of research studies supported by pharmaceutical companies and other for-profit entities.

Investigators submitting industry-sponsored research protocols are required to include the cost of initial protocol review, continuing review, and sponsored initiated full-board amendments requiring HIC review in the study budget. Fees for continuing review will be collected annually until a Closure form is received by the HIC office.

The fees are based on the assessment of costs associated with the protocol review by the HIC and are charged for services rendered. Because the HIC office commits its full resources to each review, the fees are due in full even if the HIC does not approve the study, participants are never enrolled, a research contract is never executed, or the study is terminated before objectives are reached. IRB fees are non-refundable.
